

2010 Yearling Ewe Shropshire Futurity

The American Shropshire Registry Association will sponsor a Shropshire yearling ewe futurity as part of our futurity system in 2010. The nominated ewe lambs purchased in 2009 by junior exhibitors and the ewe lambs nominated in the N.A.I.L.E. sale will be eligible for the yearling futurity. The N.A.I.L.E. sale ewe lambs will not need to be renominated by the junior exhibitor. All others will need to be renominated by April 1, 2010. The year 2010 will be the first year for the yearling ewe futurity.

CONSIGNOR RULES

1. Entries are open to all ewe lambs born September 1, 2008, thru March 31, 2009.
2. A nomination fee of \$20 was paid to The American Shropshire Registry Association. Payment was made prior to the sale of the animal.
3. Each ewe lamb must be properly identified, according to the registration certificate. Futurity ewe lambs will have their scrapie tag recorded and paint branded with an F before entering the sale ring. A representative of the National Junior Committee will do the recording.
4. Each ewe lamb must conform and abide by the rules and regulations of the individual sale to which it is consigned. All normal entry and commission fees will apply.
5. A nomination fee of \$20 is required for ewe lambs nominated at the Louisville Sale of Stars.
6. The American Shropshire Registry Association will not be responsible and shall be held harmless for any disputes and/or disagreements between buyers and sellers.

EXIBITOR RULES

1. Up to date paid membership in the junior Shropshire Breed Association.
2. A nomination fee of \$20 will be paid by the junior member. This I required and must be paid to the American Shropshire Registry Association by April 1, 2010, except ewe lambs purchased at the Stars of Louisville Sale 2009.
3. Not more that 21 years of age at the date of the N.A.I.L.E. in November.
4. Junior member must be at least 6 years of age with no partnerships or joint registrations.
5. Yearling ewes and points earned in the Futurity are not transferable to any other person, nor are the points from one ewe to another.
6. Yearling ewes are to be registered to individuals only, no and family, no partnerships, and no joint registrations.
7. Ownership of these futurity yearlings cannot have changed since their purchase as futurity lambs.
8. No Futurity entrant can compete with more than two yearling ewes. Total points earned by two yearling ewes may not be combined into one ewe's total.
9. Junior members must exhibit their own ewe within a class. If they have two ewes in the same class, another junior member may exhibit the second ewe.
10. If an exhibitor that owns an ewe is not present at the respective show-Futurity points are not eligible and should not be submitted.
11. Premiums-Based on percentages of the total amount of money collected for futurity entries.
 - FIRST: 25%
 - SECOND 20%
 - THIRD 15%
 - FOURTH 10%
 - FIFTH: 5%
 - SIXTH: 5%
 - SEVENTH 5%

EIGHTH 5%
 NINETH 5%
 TENTH 5%

Premiums and awards will be determined in November at the N.A.I.L.E. after the Junior Shropshire Show and paid within 30 days of the show. Additional recognition for the exhibitors and breeders will appear in the Shropshire Voice and on the Shropshire website.

POINT SCORING

1. A point card must be filled out for each show and forwarded to Mark McCabe, 5154 Nickelson Road, Prospect, Ohio 43342 **within 14 days of the show. Must have a postmark of 14 days or fewer to count.** The superintendent of the appropriate show must sign the card. The point card can also be scanned and emailed to mamccabe51@hotmail.com.
2. At each individual show the yearling ewe may earn Futurity points from the open division, the junior division, or from both (when a different judge or day is involved) except at N.A.I.L.E., where only the junior show placing will be counted.
3. Yearling ewes can compete at an unlimited number of shows. The exhibitor may submit as many cards as they want for that yearling ewe. Each yearling ewe's point cards will be kept separately. The five highest point award cards will be recorded as Futurity points. In the five point award cards you can include up to but no more than three county fairs.
4. Ten points is the most number of points that can be awarded per class.
5. At two shows double points are awarded. These shows are The All American Jr. Show and the National Jr. Show (at N.A.I.L.E. in 2010). The higher placing lamb at N.A.I.L.E. in Louisville will break ties.
